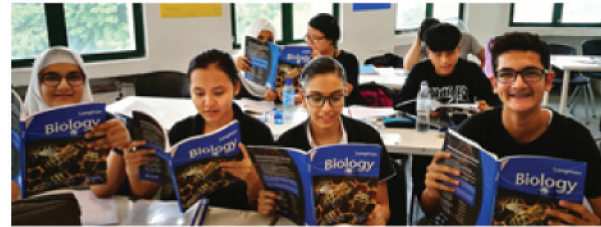
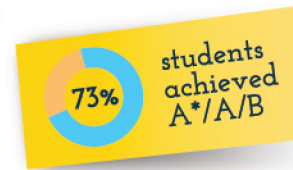

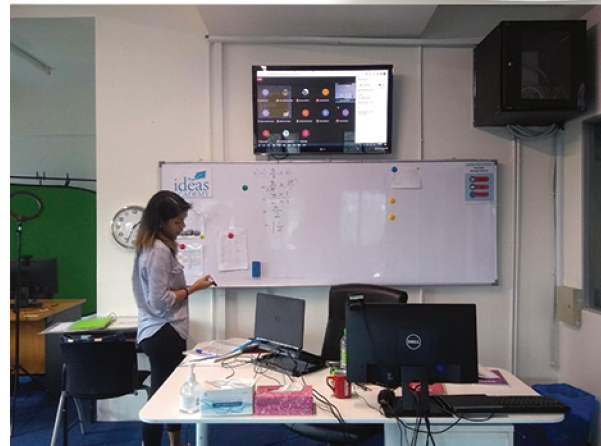
We offer the Cambridge IGCSE curriculum
